

PRE-PROFESSIONAL STUDIES AT CMU

Preparing for a Career in **KINESIOLOGY-ATHLETIC THERAPY (AT UOFW)**

A year of study at Canadian Mennonite University (CMU) could prepare you to enter a baccalaureate program in Kinesiology-Athletic Therapy. **This page explains what you must complete if you wish to gain admission at the University of Winnipeg to earn the Bachelor of Science—Athletic Therapy from the Department of Kinesiology and Applied Health.** If you intend to continue studies at some other university, similar possibilities exist. It is important, however, that you inquire about admission and program requirements at the university you are considering and that you work with the Coordinator of Student Advising at CMU to construct a program of studies at CMU that will achieve your objectives.

If you intend to earn your degree at the University of Winnipeg, you can begin with a year of studies at CMU and complete the program at the University of Winnipeg. It will be necessary to commute to the University of Winnipeg for at least 1 course during the time of pre-professional study at CMU. The course not available at CMU is highlighted in UPPERCASE LETTERS.

The University of Winnipeg does not currently have specific entrance requirements to the Athletic Therapy program, but this could change in the future. It will be important for you to inquire at the University of Winnipeg about admission requirements at the time of application. Admission may be competitive, and you may need high grades to compete successfully.

You should complete as much of the following as possible during your year at CMU:

- PHED-1000 Foundations of Physical Education and Exercise Science
- BIOL-1360 Anatomy of the Human Body
- BIOL-1370 Physiology of the Human Body
- PSYC-1010 Introduction to Psychology I
- PSYC-1020 Introduction to Psychology II
- Humanities (6 credit hours)
- Academic Writing (if required)
- Non KIN Electives (6 credit hours)*
