

Women's Volleyball Head Coach

CMU Athletics invites applications for the position of Women's Volleyball Head Coach. CMU competes in the Manitoba Colleges Athletic Conference, with the competitive schedule running from September to March.

Reporting to the Athletics Director, the Head Coach oversees the organization, administration and staffing of the Women's Volleyball program. The Head Coach assumes a key role in the recruitment of student-athletes, team selection, practices and in-season planning.

Qualifications include:

- NCCP Level 2 Certification or Advanced Development Coach trained under the new NCCP or significant volleyball coaching experience.
- Previous experience coaching elite volleyball athletes at the high school, club or post-secondary level.
- Previous experience with physical conditioning programs specific to volleyball athletes.
- The ability to recruit student-athletes and conduct volleyball selection camps.

Exceptional interpersonal, teamwork, organizational, leadership, coaching and technical skills are also required. Ability to coach during evenings (or days) and attend competitions on weekends; both home and away. Must have an understanding of university education and the Manitoba Colleges Athletic Conference.

Compensation for this position is up to \$5,000 depending upon experience and qualifications.
