## OTTATOWN LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP 2012 – 2013

CMU offers 10 **Ottatown Leadership Scholarships** (valued at \$1,000 each) to students who demonstrate significant leadership ability, academic excellence, personal character, service, and vision.

To be eligible for an **Ottatown Leadership Scholarship** students must complete this form and send it with **two** letters of nomination from two individuals closely involved in their particular area of leadership (e.g. teacher, coach, youth leader, pastor, mentor). Students are also required to submit a detailed resume and an essay. All materials must be postmarked no later than **February 28**.

If awarded, you will receive \$1000 during your Ottatown year.

### Eligibility

- is completing a High school diploma or has no more than 9 credit hours of post-secondary education
- Plans to enroll in the Ottatown program
- Has current and/or recent past leadership involvement (see below)

Note: This Leadership application and attachments will be considered again along with other Leadership applications if you decide to continue your studies at CMU. You may update any part of your application before February 28 (if you wish) of the year you apply to the Shaftesbury Campus program.

## 2. Detailed Resume, Essay and Letters of Nomination (separate attachments)

**Please submit a detailed resume.** Include the following areas of involvement as they relate to your area of leadership and achievement, starting from your grade nine year. Some areas may not apply to you.

- Award(s) received in your education (e.g. honour roll recognition, prizes)
- School leadership activities, club and/ or organization involvement and areas of volunteer involvement (e.g. Drama Club, Yearbook Committee, etc.)
- Church leadership activities or areas of church involvement
- School leadership activities and/or other volunteer involvement
- In sports, list any individual awards/recognition, and/or team successes
- In music, instruments played, including voice, and music related involvements such as band, choirs, orchestra, musicals
- Abilities and interests (such as hobbies, passions)
- Any paid work experience
- Camp involvement

**Please submit a 1000 word essay (roughly 4 pages double spaced).** In this essay tell us about a leader who inspired you, what you learned from that leader and the qualities you want to emulate. Describe your most meaningful leadership achievements. What inspires and motivates you to lead, achieve, and serve others? How does your faith relate to what you do? Finally, reflect on qualities of leadership that you want to develop while on Outtatown and beyond.

**Please submit two Letters of Nomination.** There is a separate **Leadership Nomination** Form. Please ask two people to complete this nomination form and to give reasons why you should be considered for an Outtatown Leadership Scholarship.
