



## HOUSING APPLICATION FORM

**Applications for housing** should be submitted as early as possible, preferably by February 28. Applying early will increase your chance of receiving the accommodations you want. All housing assignments are made by a CMU housing committee using the following guidelines:

### Guidelines For Housing Assignments

Dormitory Space	Apartment Space
<p>1. Full-time students will receive priority for dormitory space.</p> <p>2. Students assigned to a double occupancy room may request a specific roommate, but need to be open to having a roommate assigned.</p> <p>3. If space is available, students may apply for single occupancy in dormitory. An appropriate increase in rent will apply. Single rooms are assigned with the proviso that roommates may be assigned later if space requires it.</p> <p>Students left without a roommate through no choice of their own will not be charged an extra fee.</p>	<p>Assigned to the following students:</p> <p>1. Married students.</p> <p>2. Single students with special needs (e.g. dietary, medical).</p> <p>3. Single students with academic seniority, with other factors such as age and previous residence living also taken into consideration. Most first and second year students will be accommodated in dormitory space.</p>
